All items to be purchased from the Takapuna Grammar School Uniform Shop.

## SENIOR UNIFORM - YEARS 11, 12 & 13

**BLOUSE** short or long sleeved—light blue check, **SKIRT** dark navy box pleat, **TROUSERS** dark navy, **JERSEY** dark navy rib, **VEST** dark navy rib, **BLAZER** dark navy pin stripe with tie, **TIGHTS** black, or **SOCKS** plain black or dark navy with no logo.

or

**SHIRT** short or long sleeved—light blue check, **SHORTS** dark navy, **TROUSERS** dark navy, **JERSEY** dark navy rib, **VEST** dark navy rib, **BLAZER** dark navy pin stripe with tie, **SOCKS** plain black or dark navy with no logo.

**IMPORTANT:** The **BLAZER** is optional but when wearing the **BLAZER**, skirt length must be longer than 15 cm below hem of blazer and include the regulation blouse, tie, tights and shoes. When wearing the **BLAZER** with trousers, students must wear a school shirt, tie, socks and shoes.

## JUNIOR UNIFORM - YEARS 9 & 10

**BLOUSE** short or long sleeved—navy, **SKIRT** dark navy box pleat, **TROUSERS** dark navy, **JERSEY** dark navy rib, **VEST** dark navy rib, **BLAZER** dark navy pin stripe with tie, **TIGHTS** black, or **SOCKS** plain black or dark navy with no logo.

or

**SHIRT** short or long sleeved—navy, **SHORTS** dark navy, **TROUSERS** dark navy, **JERSEY** dark navy rib, **VEST** dark navy rib, **BLAZER** dark navy pin stripe with tie, **SOCKS** plain black or dark navy with no logo.

**IMPORTANT:** The **BLAZER** is optional but when wearing the **BLAZER**, skirt length must be longer than 15 cm below hem of blazer and include the regulation blouse, tie, tights and shoes. When wearing the **BLAZER** with trousers, students must wear a school shirt, tie, socks and shoes.

## GENERAL UNIFORM ITEMS

**JACKET** school dark navy (rain proof with hood), no other jackets are to be worn.

**SCARF** school blue and gold striped (optional), no other scarves are to be worn.

**CAPS/BUCKET HAT** school navy (optional), no other headwear to be worn. Regulation school cap or bucket hat only - not to be worn in classrooms.

**SHOES** please see Footwear over page.

**BLAZER** (optional) dark navy pin stripe with tie can be worn by both junior and senior students as part of every day uniform.

T-Shirts & Thermals worn under the uniform must not be visible

# JUNIOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION

**PE SHORTS** dark navy, **PE SHIRT** dark navy, **FOOTWEAR** lace up sports shoes (optional).  
**SWIMWEAR** appropriate for aquatic training. Rash shirts may be worn over top of swimwear.

## FOOTWEAR

In all Science laboratories and Technology rooms, students will wear the approved school black plain leather polishable shoes. Canvas shoes are not permitted. For health and safety reasons shoes are required to be sturdy and support the foot.

Footwear must be clean and have no embellishments or noticeable logos.

Sandals will be **black** or **dark brown** leather sandals with 2 toe straps. Jandal style footwear with a thong between the toes is NOT PERMITTED.

					
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## AVAILABLE FROM SCHOOL UNIFORM SHOP

All school uniform, blazer and tie, physical education uniform, scarves, caps, rain jackets and tracksuits are purchased through the Uniform Shop at Takapuna Grammar School, except footwear. Refer to school website for price and size information.

## UNIFORM REGULATIONS

### Jewellery

The following items may be worn, but no other jewellery is allowed. Items that may cause safety issues must be worn inside clothing or be removed as requested by staff. E.g. in technology, P.E, sport, and science

- o One necklace allowed 3mm or narrower, one optional small pendant (10mm or smaller - the size of a pinky fingernail or smaller).
- o Traditional Māori or Pasifika taonga may be worn, provided safety procedures are prioritised where necessary
- o The 'le Faitaga may be worn as part of the school uniform upon request and with prior approval from a Deputy Principal.
- o One plain, small sleeper or sleeper dangle drop in each ear. A dangle drop is to be no larger than the size of a small finger nail.
- o No hoops allowed.
- o Studs allowed in each ear but must be the same size or smaller than a pinhead.

**(continued)**

- o No stretcher or industrial piercings allowed
- o One nose stud, no bigger than a pinhead on the side of the nose
- o No nose rings or septum jewellery allowed
- o No other facial piercings with jewellery allowed. Clear keepers may be used
- o A watch is allowed
- o No rings, bracelets or anklets allowed
- o No other jewellery is allowed

**Tattoos**

No visible tattoos (long sleeves and long trousers must be worn to cover any body art)

There may be an exception made for Tā moko on legs, where these are part of the student's whanau traditions following discussions with the school, student and whanau

**Hair**

No facial hair

Hair in colours that are usual hair colours is allowed, no other hair colours

Ribbons, bands, combs, hijabs in school colours are allowed but no other hair accessories or ornaments

**Nails**

No longer than 2mm beyond finger ends, no artificial nails

Pastel, neutral, and clear nail polish allowed

No nail art or decorations allowed

**Makeup**

Natural looking minimal makeup is allowed.
